CIRCULAR

Sub: - Department of Education - Union Territory of Lakshadweep – Online application invited for 2nd Phase of allotment for Post Graduate and B.Ed course (at mainland) for the year 2020-2021 –Reg

Ref:- 1. This office Public Notice F.No. 65/21/2017-Edn (AW) dated 26/11/2019
2. This Office circular even number dated 16/03/2020

Submission of online application invited for the 2nd Phase allotment of **Post Graduate/B.Ed** courses (in mainland) will start from 26/11/2020 onwards and the last date for the submission of online application for 2nd phase of Post Graduate/B.Ed courses is 06/12/2020. The aspiring candidates are directed to apply online only through the official website of Lakshadweep <http://ecounselling.utl.gov.in/>. Candidates are requested to read the instructions by themselves carefully before filling the application to ensure their eligibility for different courses as per the rules laid down by the Lakshadweep Administration for the allotment of seats for higher studies and also academic qualifications prescribed by the University.

If any candidate included in the rank list of 1st phase of allotment wishes to participate in the 2nd phase for betterment need to submit request for the same to respective centres (Centres have to forward the details of such students to Directorate of Education forthwith). They are also directed to submit original selection form/sponsoring letter and undertaking for participating in the 2nd phase of allotment as per new rank list.

Centres may kindly sent the details of candidates who have surrendered original allotment letter/sponsoring letter to Directorate of Education on or before 05/12/2020 to add back such courses to online so that other candidate can opt the courses during 2nd phase.

All the candidates may take the print copy of the online application and submit to the Registration officers (Principals of all senior secondary schools in the islands) along with the following documents.

1. Scheduled Tribe Certificate.
2. SSLC (10th standard) Board exam passed certificate.
3. Copy of the mark list of the Degree exam etc (Consolidated).

The Registration Officers, consolidate the application received by them and have to verify the online applications with certificates. No officer other than the Principals of Senior Secondary Schools are authorized to receive the filled in application forms.

While receiving the filled in applications forms, the authorized officers may ensure that no application forms other than that of son, daughter, legally adopted son or daughter of local inhabitant of Lakshadweep / employees of Centre government, public sector under taking etc, which are having registered offices in Lakshadweep and having their Headquarter in the Islands and the ward has studied at least for one year in a School/ College situated in Lakshadweep. All employees other than the ethnic natives of Lakshadweep should invariably attaching a copy of Service Certificate of parent (Father or Mother) as well as detailed certificate about their ward's studies in the islands school/ Colleges in support of their claim for priority category, failing which their claim will not be considered.

As in the case of previous year (2019-2020) allotment of seats will be made by the counselling centres in the specified schools of Islands. Merit list of the candidates will be prepared on the basis of total marks obtained in the qualifying examination and allotment of entrance based course shall be subject to the entrance mark.

Course availability / institution details are published in the website are prepared as per the data available with the Department and the candidates are directed to further verify the details of the course structure, eligibility criteria and nature of the course/College (Self finance, autonomous, University and related issues pertaining to the course/institution etc) directly with the concerned institution by themselves before selecting college and course as there will not be further chance for the candidate once she/he accepted the course. The candidates are directed to refer this office public notice cited at reference 1st for more details (copy enclosed)

From the year 2016-17 onwards, the allotment of seats available at Calicut University centres of Androth and Kadmath is carrying out by the Directorate of Education. Candidate aspiring post Graduate seats form the Calicut University centres of Androth and Kadmath should apply through online. The same will be allotted through counselling along with other colleges.

Rules framed by the Lakshadweep Administration for the purpose is applicable for the allotment of Post Graduate courses.

The Department will not accept any kind of plain application for the online seat allotment and hence the candidates are directed to submit their applications through online mode only. No recommendation letter shall be issued to the students as per their request for any course (the circular cited at reference 2nd enclosed for reference)

While filling the application form, if a candidate furnish false/wrong information or suppress any facts, such application will be rejected and action will be taken against such candidates


The applicants are required to furnish unique mobile number against each application in a course level and the same will be verified by means of OTP at the time of registration. This would ensure that the information sent with respect to allotment 2020 is reaching on candidate mobiles.

The number of counselling centre shall be limited at Senior Secondary Schools in Amini, Agatti, Androth, Chetlat, Kadmath, Kalpeni, Kavaratti, Kiltan, Minicoy.

Last year it was experienced that candidates are taking much time to select College and courses. Such delay is preventing to complete listed students for the day. So to avoid such delay in counselling, only **5 minutes** will be allowed for a candidate to select course at the time of counselling. Count down will be started from the beginning of counselling of a student. If the candidate has failed to exercise his/her choice within 5 minutes (Count Down come to zero) the software will reject the candidate's chance and candidate will be allowed to select the course and subject, only after completing the whole students listed for counselling for the day. So all the candidates should come with preparation for counselling.


The principals of all islands shall be designated as the Registration Officers of the Counselling and they have to furnish authenticated data directly to the officials concerned in the NIC. The candidates should not submit application for Higher Studies to the Directorate of Education.

The Registration Officers of all Island are being informed that they can modify/ Correct the data uploaded form their end if required since the Department of Education will not do any kind of modification.
