OFFICE ORDER.

Sub: General Guidelines for the Admission to the Government Colleges in Lakshadweep –reg
Ref: 1.This Office Circular File No.: LD-23004/1/2025-Acd-Wng-Dir of Edn date 16.05.2025

The Department of Education is pleased to issue the following guidelines to regulate admissions to the Government Colleges in Lakshadweep established under this Department, in order to bring qualitative reforms in the institutions at Androth, Kadmat, and Minicoy. Accordingly, the following directions shall be applicable to all Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) under the Department:

1. Online seat allotment for the courses in Government College of Arts & Science, Androth; Government College of Arts & Science, Kadmat; and Government Polytechnic College, Minicoy shall be completed by the first week of June every year.
2. Seat allotment for the courses in Government College of Education, Kadmat shall be completed within two weeks from the date of announcement of the degree examination results.
3. A student who has been allotted a seat in any Government College in Lakshadweep shall not be permitted to apply for another seat under the Lakshadweep quota during the same academic year.
4. A student who discontinues a course shall not be considered for admission to any course in the same college or any other college in Lakshadweep for the next three academic years.
5. No seats shall be allotted after the closure of admissions as notified by the University concerned.
6. Admission for fresh UG/B.Voc./D.Voc batches shall not be conducted in the colleges at Androth and Kadmat if the number of applicants are 30% or below of the approved intake.

The Department of Education reserves the right to commence or discontinue any course during the academic year, or at any time, in the interest of maintaining academic standards or meeting administrative requirements. In such cases, students who have opted for seats in island institutions shall be allotted seats in mainland institutions against the seats reserved by the Administration.

The seat allotment agency/section shall provide proper orientation regarding the above norms, especially the condition relating to the minimum number of admissions required for conducting fresh UG/B.Voc./D.Voc.batches, so that students may opt for courses in mainland institutions if admissions to the above courses are suspended due to non-availability of the minimum required number of candidates.

It is further directed that the seat allotment agency shall obtain course-wise approved intake details of various courses in the colleges of Lakshadweep from the Directorate of Education every year prior to initiating the online seat allotment process, and allotments shall be made strictly against the courses approved by the Department.

The Principals of all Higher Educational Institutions under the Department of Education are hereby strictly directed to take effective measures to prevent dropout and discontinuation of students from their respective institutions, as poor student strength adversely affects the continuation of batches and the effective functioning of the Higher Educational Institutions.

These instructions shall come into force with immediate effect.
